As a result of their strong performance, the team qualified for the True Team State Meet held this past Saturday at the University of Minnesota. The team finished 9th at the State meet. We are so excited for the boys this year.

The Orono Girls Hockey is also having a tremendous season with 6 consecutive wins. They are undefeated in conference play and have a season record of 17 wins and 2 losses. They are currently ranked No. 2 in Class 1A in the coaches association poll. We will look forward to the next few weeks of competition.

On Friday, January 28, the Orono Unified Club will host a Unified Basketball Tournament at the Activities Center. Orono's Unified team will enjoy a fun day of competition against other area players. We are grateful to Special Olympics Minnesota, the high school Unified Club, and all the volunteers for planning an incredible event.
