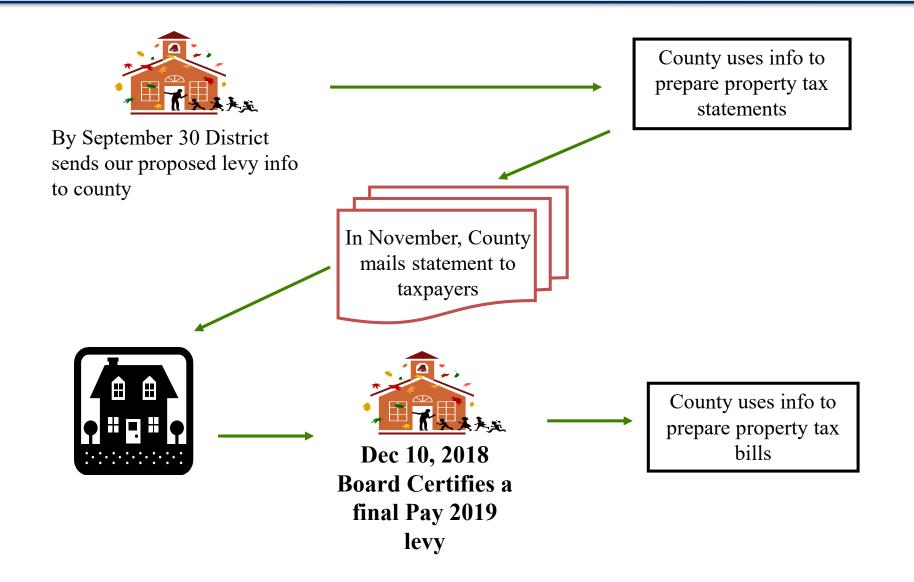

School levies don't fit the yearly cycle like Cities and Counties



District is working on Three Fiscal years at any given time



2019 Property Tax Levy Highlights

- ➤ Operating Referendum inflationary increase of \$288,108. This accounts for 50.6% of the overall increase.
- > Refunding of OPEB Bonds reduced annual tax impact by (-\$60,268) versus 2018.
- ➤ Health & Safety, Deferred Maintenance, & Student Achievement levies all have been sunset and no longer have an impact.

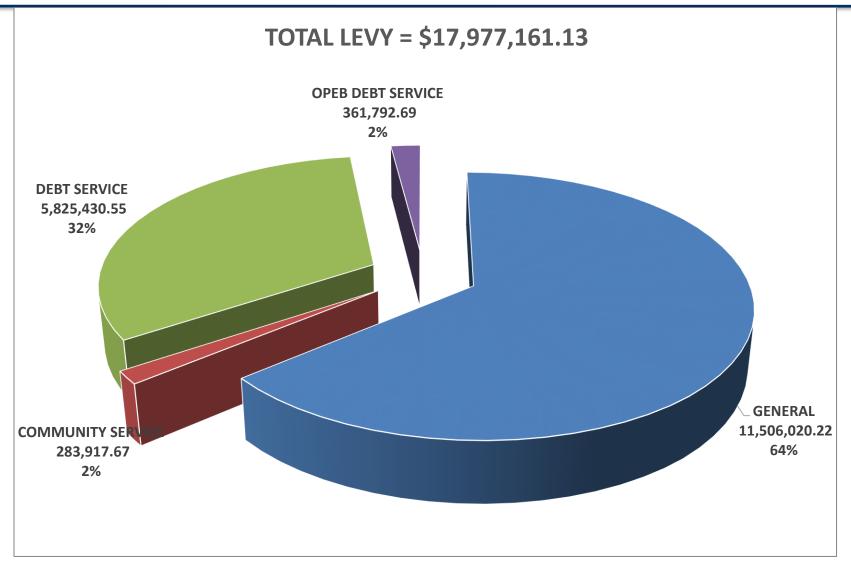


2019 Property Tax Levy Highlights

- Equity calculation increased by \$71,774 or 12.6% of the total levy increase. An Equity adjustment of \$51,436 or 9.0% of the levy increase was also included.
 - Regular equity revenue is calculated by ranking all districts in each region according to their total basic and referendum revenue. Districts below the 95th percentile of revenue in those two components combined are eligible for regular and low-referendum equity revenue. Many districts increased referendum revenue, which affected Orono's equity calculation.
- ➤ Capital Projects Levy (Technology) increased by \$53,866 or 9.5% of the levy increase. This levy is base on the Net Tax Capacity of the District.
- \triangleright Total levy will increase of 3.27% next year

Three Funds in the Levy

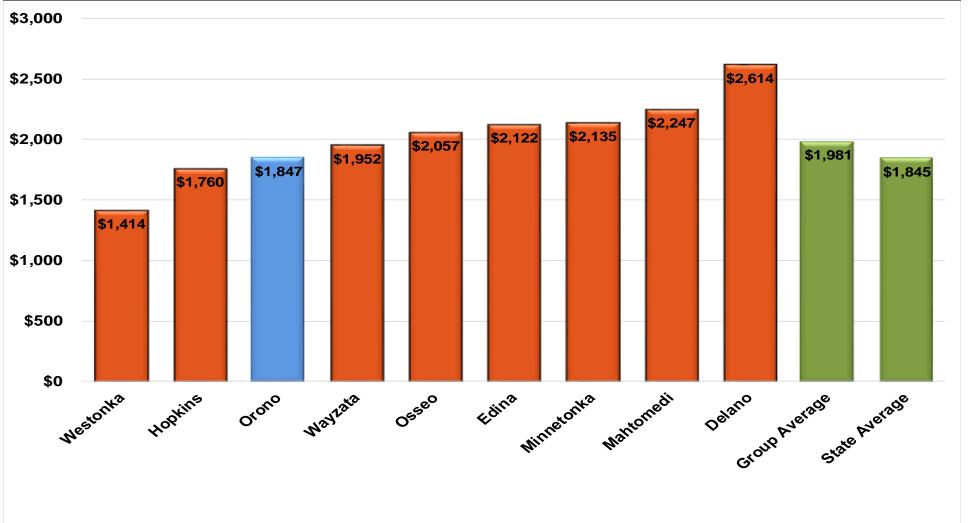
- General Fund
 - > 24.3% comes from the levy
- > Community Service Fund
 - \geq 8.8% comes from the levy
- > Debt Service Fund
 - \geq 100.0% comes from the levy

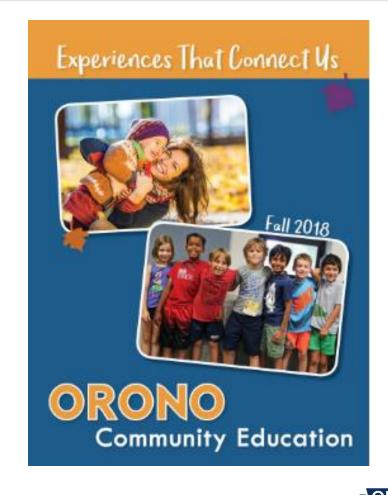


Community Service Levy

➤ Basic Community Service Levy

Early Childhood/ Family Education

- > School Age Childcare
 - > (Before & After School)



Levy provides approximately 9% of total budget

Debt Service Levy

Used to pay the District's long term debt

- > This debt is used for:
 - **➤ Building Projects**
 - ➤ Indoor Activity Center (2017)
 - **➤ Major Maintenance Projects**
 - ➤ Deferred Maintenance Project (2008)
 - ➤ Parking Lot Maintenance (2018)
 - **➢Other Post Employment Benefits (OPEB)**



2018-19 Budget

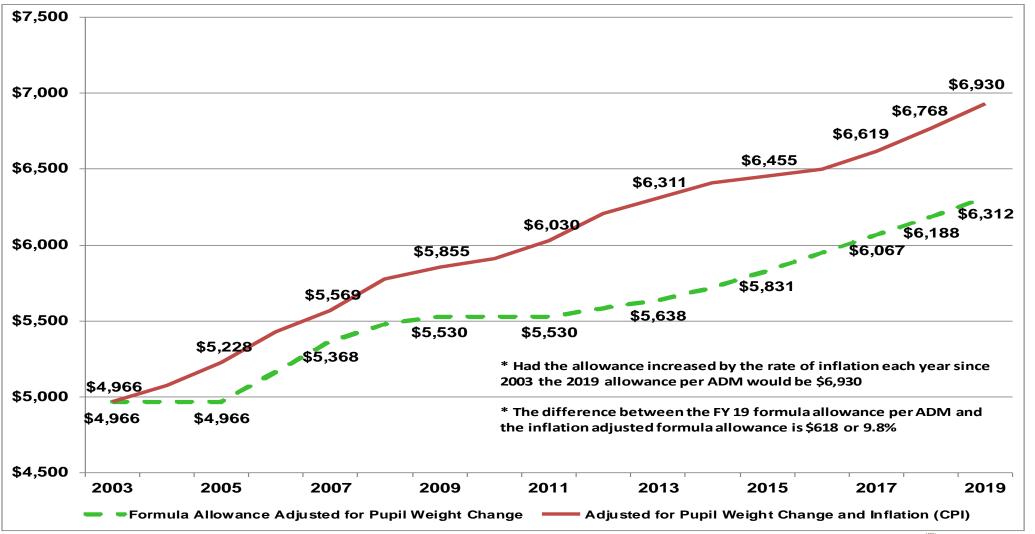
Highlights:

- ≥1.2% Increase in Enrollment
 - ➤ Added a 9th section to Kindergarten
- >2% increase in per pupil funding
- Enrollment study predicting 6.6% residential growth over the next <u>five</u> years
 - Monitored monthly with adjustments to Open Enrollment assumptions to manage growth
- ➤ Investment in Teacher training, Staff Development, Literacy, and a focus on Math
- >Activities Center operational in February

General Education Formula Allowance, 2003-2019 Adjusted for Pupil Weight Change and Inflation (CPI)



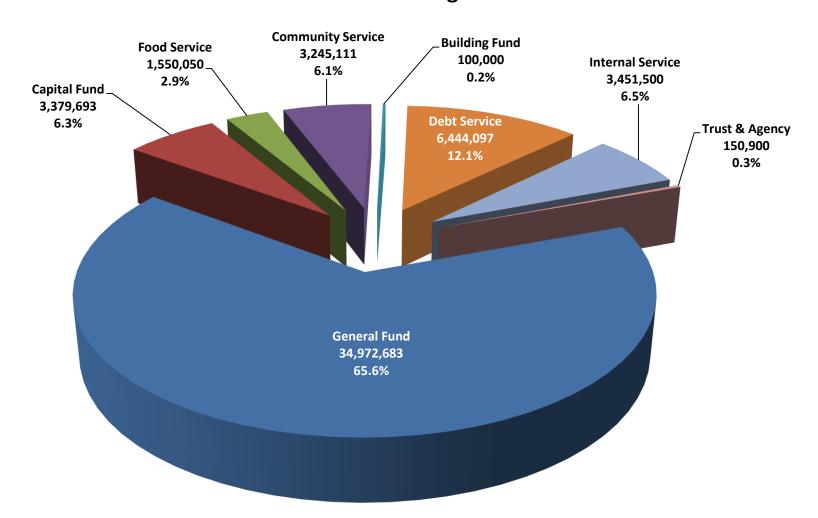




2018-19 Revenue by Fund

2018-19 Revenue Budget - All Funds

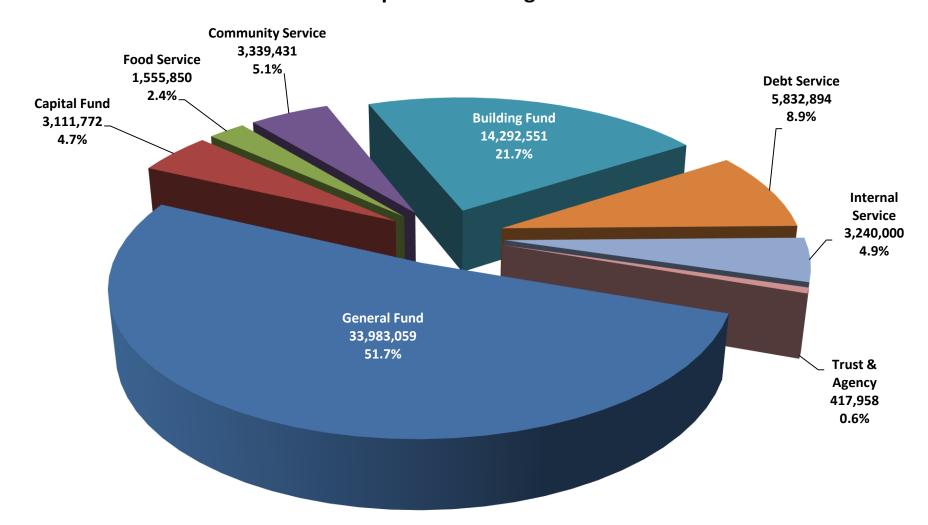




2018-19 Expenditures by Fund

\$65,773,515

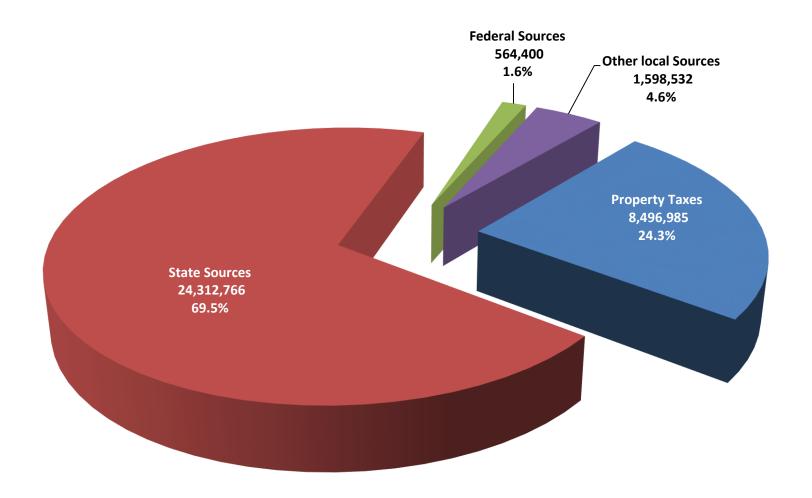
2018-19 Expenditure Budget - All Funds





2018-19 Revenues by Source

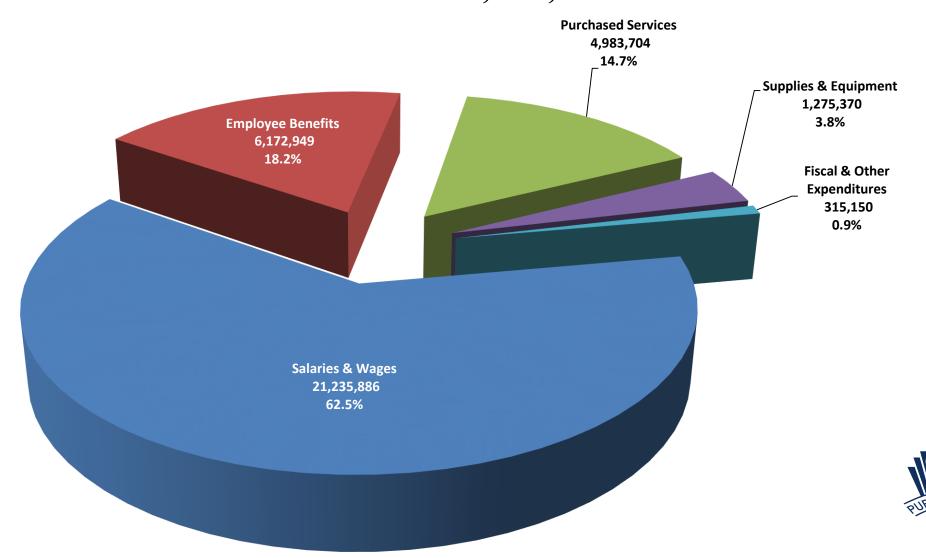
General Fund \$34,972,683





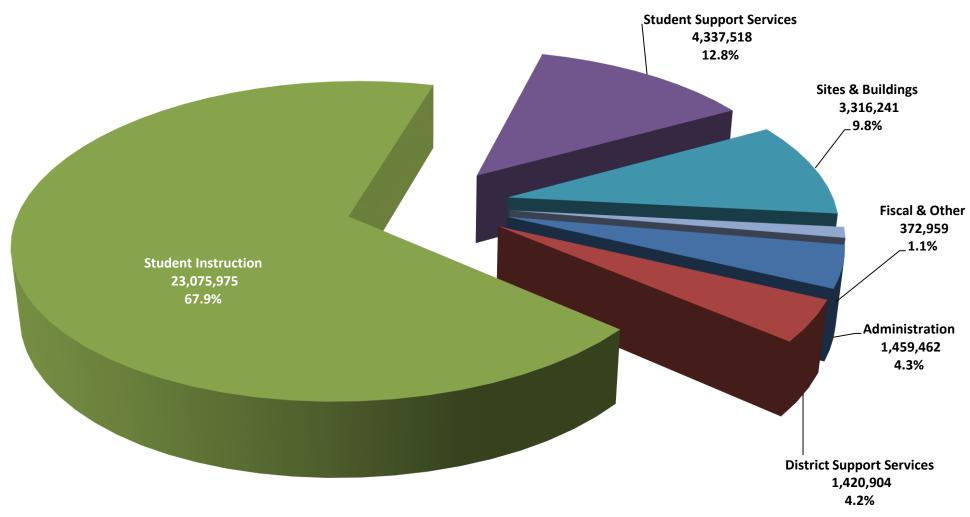
2018-19 Expenditures by Object Area
